Truax Flex II Drill

DNR owns the equipment and Calhoun Conservation District oversees the rental during planting seasons, in cooperation with Farm Service Agency and Natural Resources Conservation Service.

Guidelines for Proper Use of the 5' Span Drill

- 1.. Maintain the drill in accordance with the manufacturer's recommendations. Truax Flex II Drill owner's manual can be found on their website or a hard copy is available through the Calhoun Conservation District office.
2. Be responsible for calibrating, transportation to the fields, and proper use in the fields. Return drill rinsed off and clean from planting for the next person using the equipment.
3. Drills are not to be pulled at speeds faster than 25 mph on the road and in the fields.
4. Drills require a minimum of 40 horsepower tractor with hydraulics to operate.
5. Drills are only to be used in fields that are suitable for planting ie: free of root balls, large stones and other debris which can damage the drill planting mechanism and tires.

Truax Flex II Drill for Planting Grasses and Wildflowers

1. The drills are to be used only for purposes of assisting landowners to implement operations for the conservation of farmland and natural resources. Planting Wildflowers, Native Warm Season Grasses, Cool Season Grasses, and food plots/pastures or any combination of those seeds are permitted.
2. The drills are not to be rented out for the purpose of planting cash crop fields, commercial operations, or for other financial gain.
